

## **Cancellations**

For cancellations made 1 month ahead of your session (4 weeks before the first day of camp) you will receive your deposit back.

For cancellations made 2 - 4 weeks ahead of your session (before the first day of camp) you will receive your deposit back if your spot can be filled.

For cancellations made less than two weeks before the first day of camp, we will be unable to return your deposit

## Presbycamp 2010 Summer

Presbycamp is sponsored by First Presbyterian Church, Santa Barbara. It is a program designed to serve its own members and the community. Our goal is to provide fun, learning, wholesome fellowship, and the experience of building quality relationships between staff, CITs (counselors in training), and campers.

These five day sessions will offer on and off campus activities. Presbycamp is staffed by paid employees and volunteers under a camp director. The 2010 Presbycamp weeks will be co-directed by Susan and Mark Croshaw. Our counselor to camper ratio is usually 1:5.

The Summer sessions are:

- Week 1: June 7-11
- Week 2: June 14-18
- Week 3: June 21-25
- Week 4: June 28-July 2
- Week 5: July 6-9 (short week)
- Week 6: July 12-16

## Registration and Cost

\$ 150 for the five (and four) day session. A \$30 deposit per child, per week is required to secure enrollment. This deposit is put toward your cost for the week. The balance is due on the first day of camp. Please complete both sides of the registration form. You will receive email or written verification of your enrollment. There is a \$15 maximum discount per child for...

- members of First Presbyterian Church
- families with more than one camper
- campers who have siblings in the FP Church Early Childhood Center (ECC)

## Activities

Presbycamp activities include chapel, crafts, games, education, library visits, and community service. We leave the church campus every day (during the ECC nap times).

## Transportation

Daily trips are made in the First Presbyterian Church vans. The drivers hold the appropriate licenses. The vans are equipped with seatbelts, phones, and a list of local Starbucks.
